Curator 30 Minute Fridays occur on a Friday every three months. The goal is to build a series of social networks and support mechanisms with the local community. The sessions deploy a conversational format for artists, writers and other cultural producers to meet and discuss their work, proposals, or grant writing feedback within a 30 minute session. The AGM strives to become a nexus for the community of Mississauga, utilize the new Resource Room as a backdrop of knowledge. **By appointment only.**

Selection Process:

Due to limited space and strong interest in these appointments, **applications will be pre-selected.** To be considered, please send the following to agm.connect@mississauga.ca:

- **Subject line:** Registration: 30 Minutes with a Curator | [Artist Name]
- a CV and artist statement as single PDF document
- 5 images of your work in JPG format
- Include in the body of the e-mail specific topics you wish to discuss in the meeting. Examples include:
 - Feedback on my artwork
 - Advice on writing a grant
 - Talk about art and ideas
 - Strategize my career

Guidelines for Cultural Producers

- Each session is strictly 30 minutes.
- Provide a print version of the following at your appointment:
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Exhibition History
 - Artist Statement
 - Artist Biography
- Bring images of your work. Maximum of 10 images on a flash drive or CD, or in photograph form (maximum size 8 x 10”).
- Do NOT bring works such as paintings or sculptural objects. The curator will look ONLY at images.
- For optimum viewing, we suggest that artists bring their own laptops.
- If the artist is working on a grant or any piece of text, bring multiple copies of the same text.
- Bear in mind that exhibitions are booked 3-4 years in advance. **Curator 30 Minute Fridays** is NOT a process to gain an exhibition at the AGM. Rather, it is meant to build a relationship with the AGM, and for us to get to know the artists and cultural producers in the region.
