ENTRY FEE: \$45 **PAYMENT:** Non-refundable. Entry fees are payable through the online application or in person at the AGM during gallery hours.

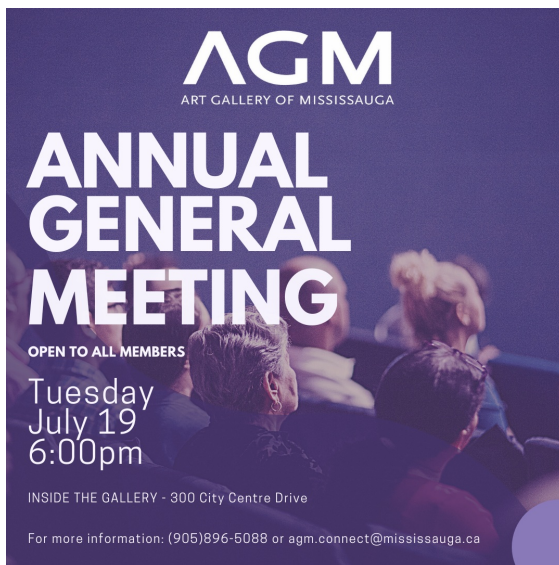
All entry fees must be paid in full prior to application deadline of July 29.

TERMS OF ENTRY: Applications are only accepted electronically and should be sent through our online form. Artists may submit 1 recent piece (completed between 2019–2022) for jurying. Open to all emerging and established artists 18 years of age and older, living and working in Ontario.

Submissions can include paintings in any medium, drawings, mixed media, fibre art and sculpture, photography, new media and video.

We are back!

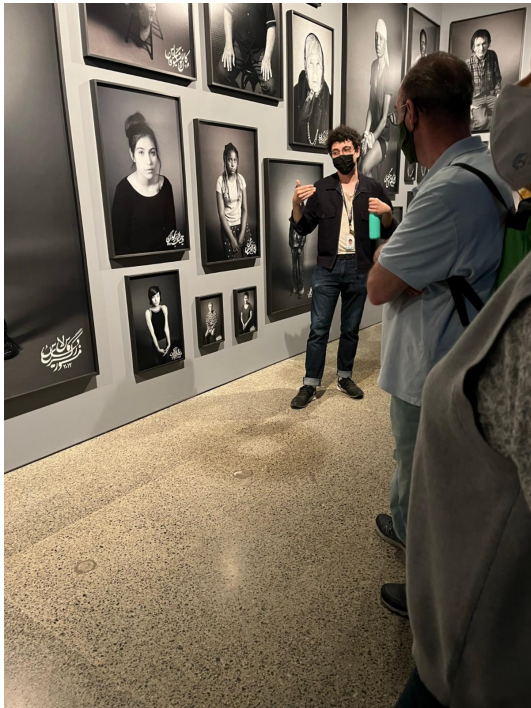
In July we will back at Erin Mills Town Centre with our free arts and crafts workshop series for people of all ages.

Last month, with the help of funds from Charity Gaming and RAMA Meadowvale, the Art Gallery of Mississauga launched an ART BUS tour of three exhibitions that were part of the CONTACT Photography Festival.

Starting at the Art Gallery of Mississauga visitors got a tour of *View Find[H]er*, an exhibition that featured 7 local women photographers.

Next, we boarded the bus for the Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA) in Toronto's west end to see Shirin Neshat's *Land of Dreams* with a guided tour. The final stop took us to the Textile Museum of Canada (TMC) to see a fascinating show of works by photographer Aida Muluneh titled *Water Life*. As we journeyed through this gallery, we also discovered art making stations that got visitors engaged with weaving and sewing.

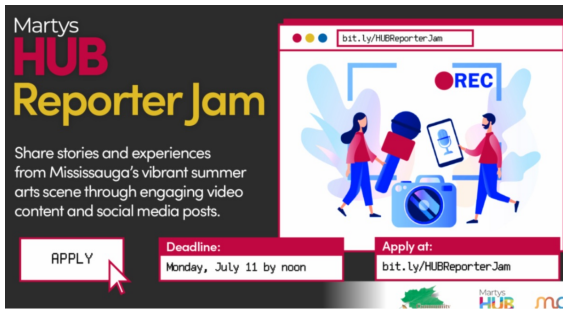
