Mississauga, ON – The Art Gallery of Mississauga (AGM) is proud to announce *The Further Apart Things Seem*, an exhibition exploring the possibility of finding common ground in a social and political moment where opinions are often divisive. From February 7 to April 6, 2023, the exhibition will feature works by artists pursuing subtle forms of resistance and testing the unexpected to build resilience, resolution, and understanding.

In a time where debates over human rights, climate change, land claims, and even the politicizing of the pandemic often seem at cross-purposes and irresolvable, the possibility of finding common ground can seem beyond reach. *The Further Apart Things Seem* invites audiences to consider how we respond in times of uncertainty—when do we push forward, when do we give up, and when do we try things differently? The exhibition features artists who follow distinct paths toward subtle forms of resistance while exploring areas of connection between that which feels disconnected or in opposition. Through material experimentation and provisionally, they offer productive spaces for building resilience, resolution, and understanding.

The exhibition is co-presented by Contemporary Calgary, the University of Waterloo Art Gallery, and the Art Gallery of Mississauga. It is supported by the City of Mississauga, the Ontario Arts Council, the Canada Council for the Arts, the Ontario Trillium Foundation, RAMA Gaming House Mississauga, and Charitable Gaming, Community Good.
