



## NEW ACQUISITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The AGM is proud to announce the purchase of Jorian Charlton's *Kifaaya II* for its permanent collection. Charlton is a Mississauga-based artist whose photographic practice considers notions of Black representation. Her work was featured in the solo exhibition *Jorian Charlton: Between Us* at the Art Gallery of Mississauga earlier this year.

*Kifaaya II* is one of a triptych of images from the exhibition featuring a young girl in colourful dress. Typical of Charlton's work, the image emphasizes the beauty and style of her subjects while exploring contemporary modes of Black representation through setting, gesture, pose, and clothing.

"I appreciate the vulnerable nature of having your photo taken," Charlton has said. "Each subject is unique in their own way, and this is



something I always strive to bring out in my photos.”

## GOOD NEWS STORY

Rick Hansen students collaboratively create at the Art Gallery of Mississauga

On Friday October 27, teacher Rita Pannu, from Rick Hansen Public School, arrived at the Art Gallery of Mississauga with 22 of her students to participate in an art workshop. Artist Stephanie Schirm led the class in a creative process to make a collaborative artwork based on Tom Thomson's iconic painting *Jack Pine* (1916-1917). The students painted over 45 square canvases which we assembled at the end of the workshop to create a kind of mosaic work that shines with the forms and colours of Thomson's original work. The students, however, added their own originality to the work and created something wonderful!
