This inter-generational art series brings together Seniors and Youth (ages 12 – 18) to share stories and create multi-media art works that reflect the meaning of the objects in our lives. Through drawing, freewriting, collage, and assemblage prompts, we'll look at objects from different angles and uncover their stories and their possibilities, asking what things are and what else they could be. You'll get your own supply kit and at the end of the course, we'll showcase our own mini museum of collaborative artworks that tell the stories of our family heirlooms, cultural artifacts, and found objects from our city.
